THE NEW ENGLAND JUNIOR INVITATIONAL

Format: Invitational event where (7) junior boy golfers and three (5) junior girl golfers from each of the New England State Golf Associations are selected to compete in a 54 hole team and individual stroke play competition.

Selection Criteria: The winner of the current Junior Championship will get an automatic invite. The remainder of the team will be selected based on the Player of the Year points standings. The Player of the Year list will guide in the selection process, but final decisions will also be made at the discretion of the Director of Junior Golf.
